

VIETNAMESE TEACHERS AND LEARNERS' ATTITUDES TOWARD TEACHING ENGLISH THROUGH E-LESSON PLANS

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ABSTRACT

The study examined the attitudes of teachers and students towards teaching English through elesson plans for the tenth graders at Le Thanh Hien High School in Tien Giang province, Viet Nam. It also aimed at exploring the usage of e-lesson plans in teaching English at this school. The participants consisted of 245 tenth graders chosen from 6 classes and 10 teachers of English. Two sets of questionnaires for teachers and students followed by interviews with teachers were instruments for data collection. The findings indicated that e-lesson plans were a common practice at this school. In general, the teachers and students were eager to accept this new tool of teaching and were fully aware of the benefits that e-lesson plans bring about. The results of the study also revealed that the participants possessed positive attitudes towards the advantages of using e-lesson plans in teaching English. In contrast, they expressed unfavorable views about e-lesson plans' disadvantages and reported some obstacles to the implementation of this teaching tool.
