ABSTRACT

This study aims to examine the errors on the usage of verbs in English essay of comparison and contrast method written by 36 tertiary level EFL learners at International Islamic University Chittagong (IIUC), Bangladesh. This study examines the errors of agreement with verb, missing of verbs, misusing verb tense, misusing past tense after infinitive and misusing "to have" verb.
